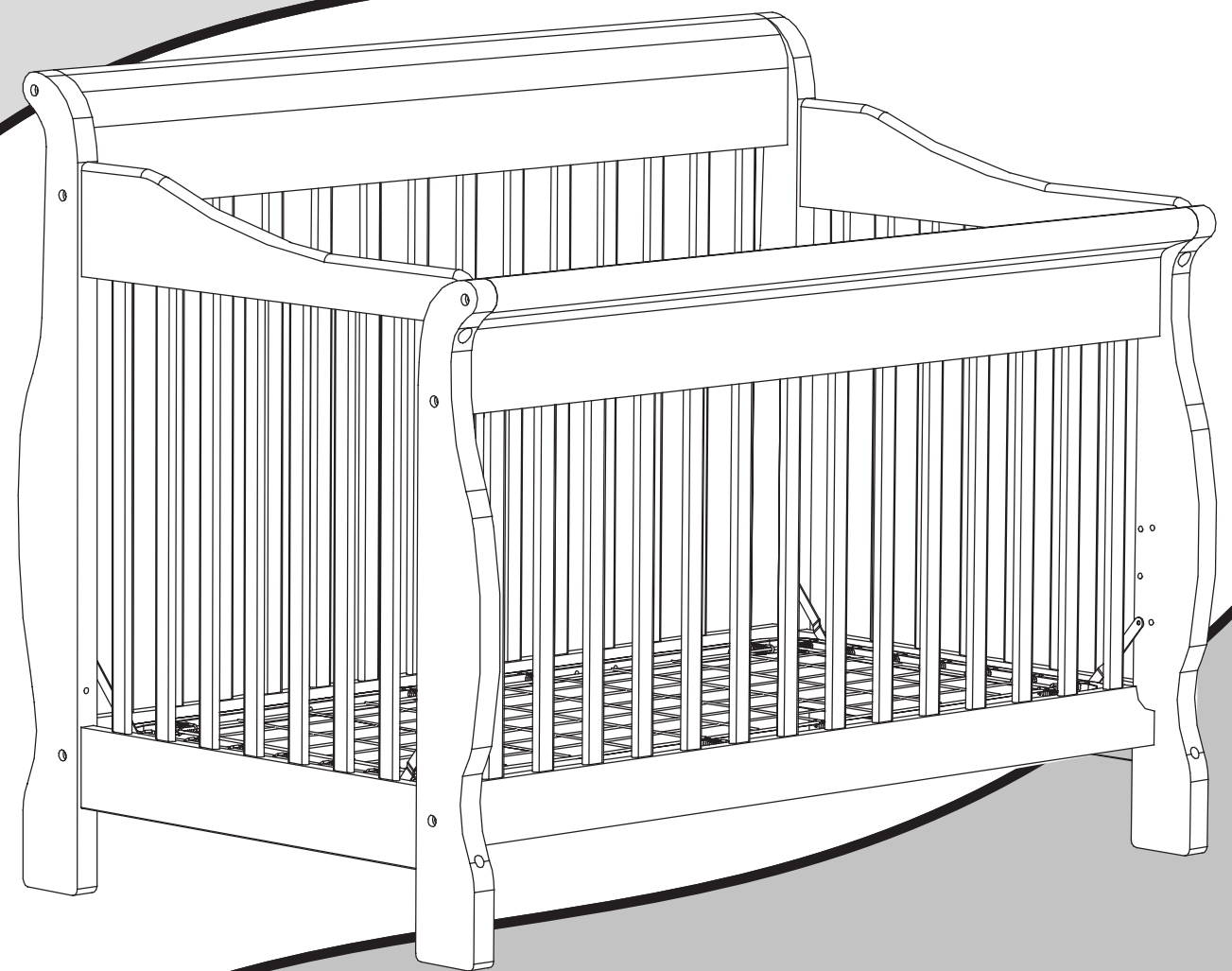

After product is assembled make sure all bolts and screws are securely tightened. Store this instruction manual in the envelope attached to the mattress base for future reference.

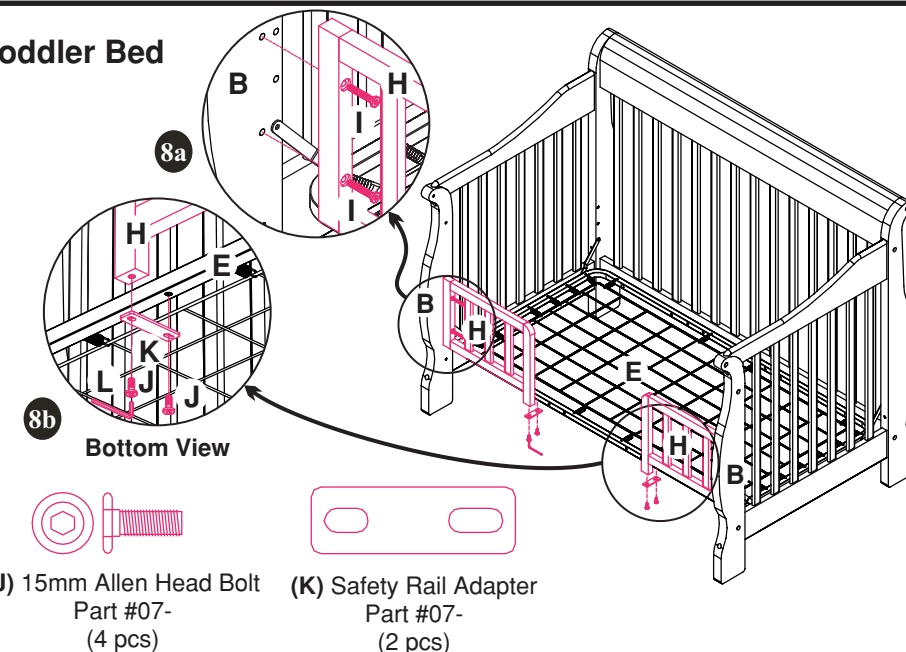
Please read these instructions before use of this product. Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death. Please save manual for future use as it contains important information.

- **Read all instructions before assembling crib. KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.** Do not use this crib if the instructions can not be strictly followed.
- **CAUTION:** Any mattress used on this crib must be at least 27-1/4 inches (69 cm) by 51-5/8 inches (131 cm) with a thickness not exceeding 6 inches (15 cm).
- **DO NOT** use a water mattress with this crib.
- Ensure a safe environment for your child by checking regularly, (that every component is properly and securely in place) before placing your child in the crib. Making sure that all bolts and fasteners are tight.
- Before each usage or assembly, inspect crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing or broken. Ask your dealer or write to manufacturer for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- When child is able to pull to a standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (90 cm), the crib shall no longer be used and can be converted to the transitional bed.
- Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- **DO NOT** place crib near window where child may fall out or where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle the child. **DO NOT** place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near the crib.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- If refinishing or touching up, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing, damaged, or broken. Contact BabyAGE for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- Infant can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow, comforter or padding.

8 Converting Crib to Toddler Bed

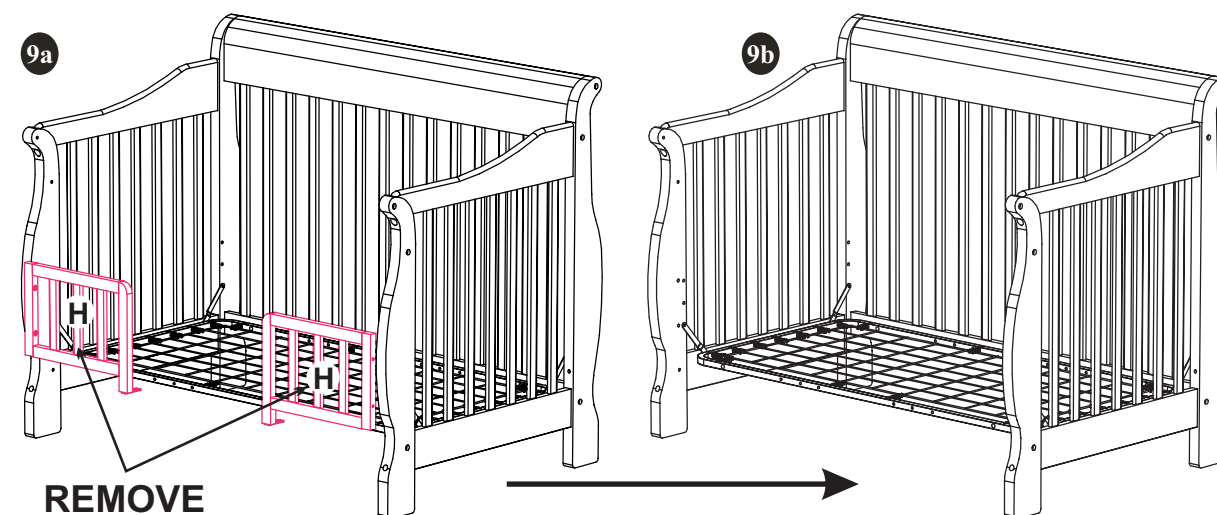
Remove the **Front Rail (E)** and the **Top Rail (G)** at the front. Attach one of the **Safety Rail (H)** to the End Board, and bolt in using two **45 mm Bolts (I)** as shown in 8a.

Line up the **Adapter (K)** with the holes on the bottom of **Mattress Base (E)** and of **Safety Rail (H)** then bolt in using two **15 mm Bolts (J)** as shown in 8b. Repeat for the other safety rail.



9 Converting to Day Bed

Simply remove both **Safety Rails (H)** and your Day Bed is ready to use.

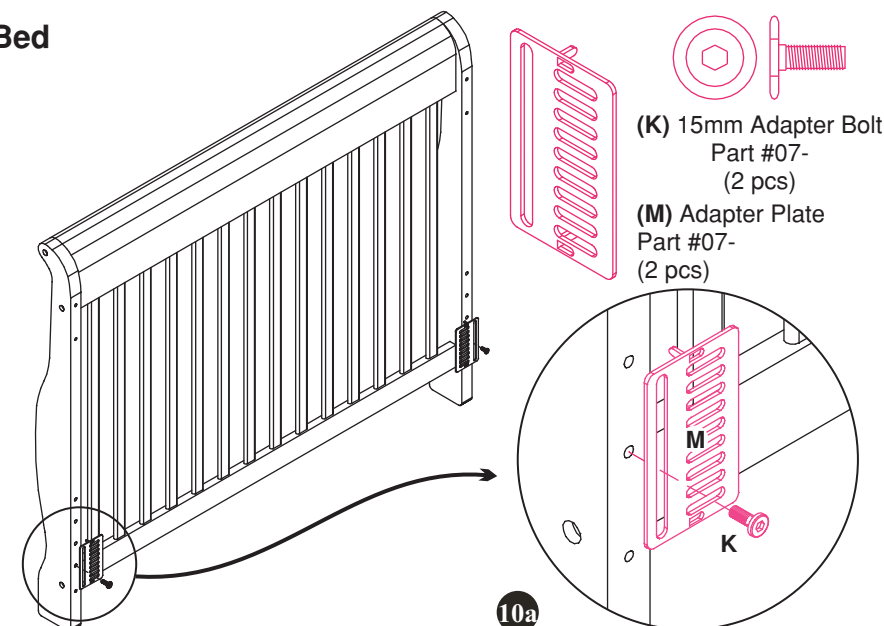


9 Converting to Full Size Bed

NOTE: Bed frames are not supplied with this system, but can be purchased at mattress stores.

Attach Adapter Plate (**M**) with Adapter Bolt (**K**) to each side of headboard. Adjust up or down to allow for connection to bed rail. Adapter "tabs" will keep adapter plate from rotating.

Stand headboard up. Attach to bed frame with bolts and nuts (supplied by bed frame manufacturer). Adapter plates can be adjusted up or down to best suit bed frame. Tighten all bolts once bed rail is adjusted.

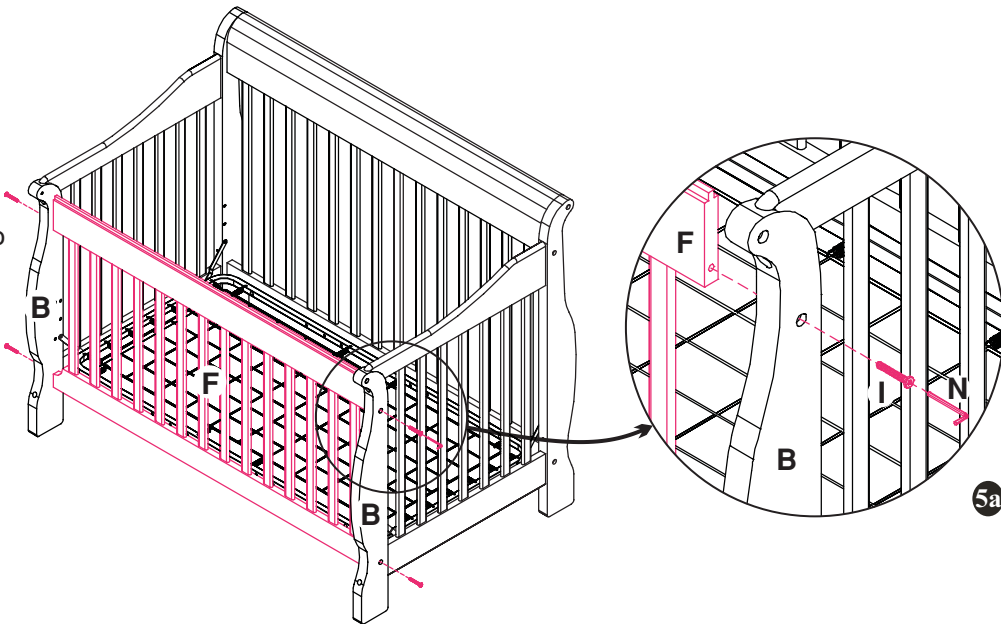

Bolt the **Front Rail (D)** to the two end boards with four **45 mm Bolts (I)**.

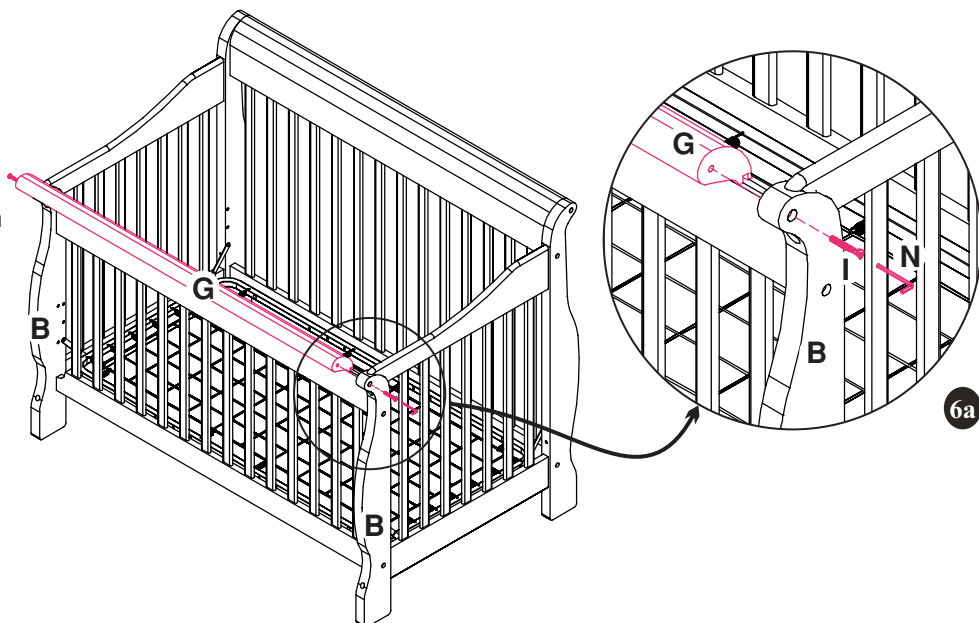

Bolt the other **Top Rail (G)** to the two ends with **45 mm Bolts (I)**. And as in step 3, ensure the **Front Rail (E)** lined up with the groove on the Top Rail.

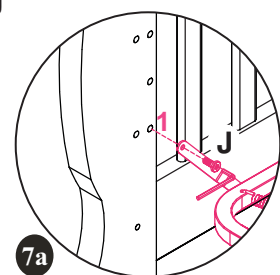
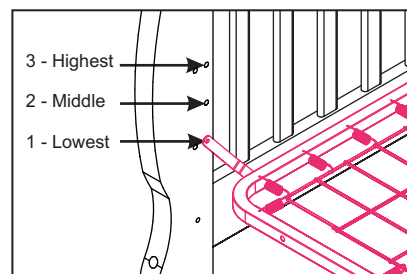

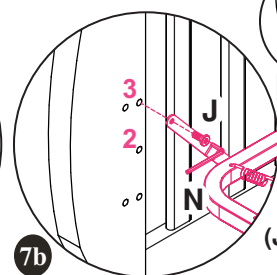
Mattress Base Position Adjustment

To adjust the Mattress Base, remove **Bolts (J)** from the Mattress Base on the Lowest position (1) as shown in **7a**.

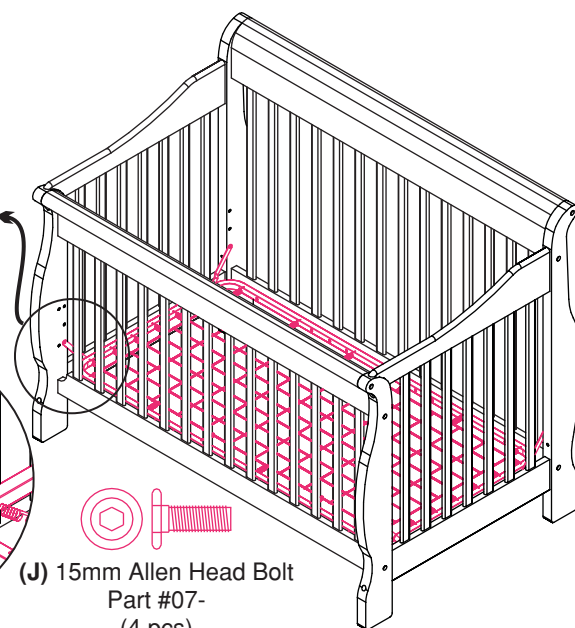
Reinstall Mattress Base in new holes (2 or 3) depending on desire height as shown in **7b**. Please ensure that Bolts are tight and Mattress is secured prior usage.

Toddler Bed Warnings

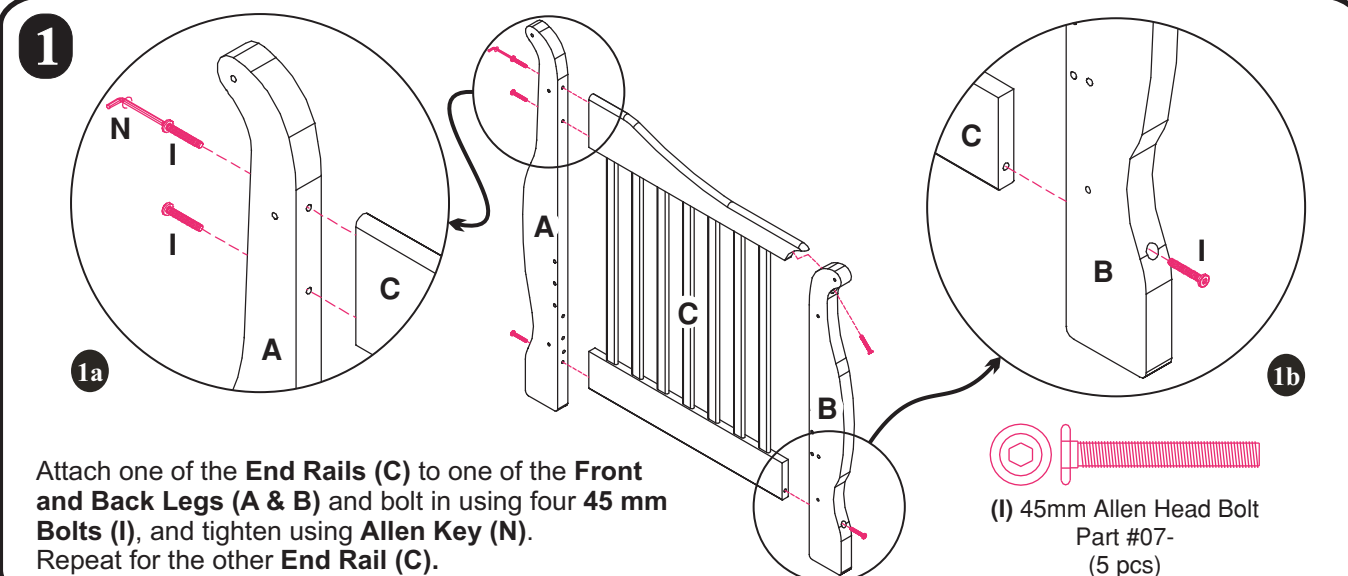
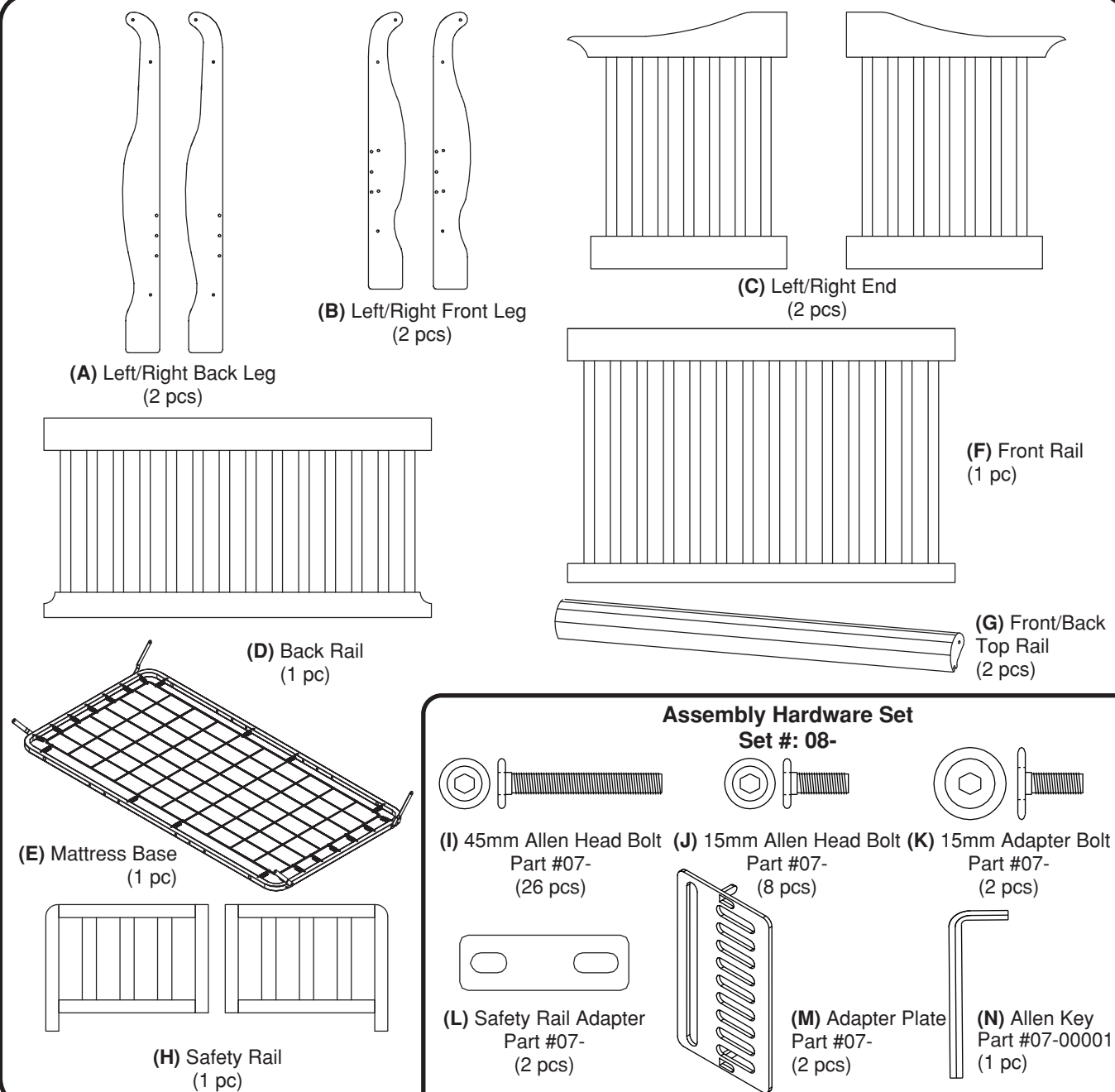
FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH FROM ENTRAPMENT OR STRANGULATION.

- **DO NOT** place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- READ INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE assembling bed. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.** Do not use this bed if the instructions can not be strictly followed.
- CAUTION: The mattress intended for use on this bed shall be a full size crib mattress having minimum dimensions of 51-5/8 inches (1310 mm) in length and 27-1/4 inches (690 mm) in width and 4 inches (100 mm) in thickness..
- The minimum age shall not be less than 15 months and the maximum weight shall not be greater than 50lbs (22.7kg).
- Do not use a water mattress with this bed.
- Do not place items with a string, cord, or ribbon around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- Do not suspend strings over a toddler bed for any reason.
- Make sure to place this bed in your child's room keeping in mind hazards such as windows, walls and other pieces of furniture. Windows are dangerous if the child can use the bed to climb out of the window. For other pieces of furniture and walls, a min of 12 inches is recommended between the bed and the furniture or wall, to reduce the risk a child may slide into the smaller spaces and suffocate.
- **DO NOT** place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

Maintenance, Cleaning and Storage

- Regularly check to make sure that the bolts are all fastened tightly. Due to regular wear and tear, they can come loose.
- To clean bed, use only mild household soap and warm water. Do not use bleach or detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners which can scratch the finish of the bed. Use clean soft cloths to wash, rinse and dry. With proper care, the quality finish will last a long time. Wood surfaces may be treated with light application of a good grade of non-toxic furniture polish.
- When this toddler bed is no longer needed, follow the assembly steps in reverse to dismantle it and store it in a safe and dry place so that it will not pose a danger to any child.
- Store all hardware and these instructions inside the envelope attached to the mattress base to keep it safe and handy for future use.
